Honourable Chair and dear delegates,

As the delegation of Poland, we believe that securing post conflict peace is crucial in today's world. A statement has been made on behalf of the European Union and associated and aligned countries, welcoming the Council's continued efforts in responding to the challenges of combining peacekeeping and peacebuilding, regarding the new peacekeeping operations. We agreed as the 5th most populous member state of the European Union.

We have the ABW (Agencia Bezpieczenstwa Wewnetrznego) officially the Internal Security Agency. It is responsible for analysing, reporting, and preventing threats to Poland's internal security, including terrorism, foreign espionage, arms smuggling, drug trafficking, organized crime, corruption, and economic coercion. Its powers include arresting individuals, conducting searches and investigations, and combating terrorism with a specialized armed anti-terrorist force.

Poland adopted its first National Action Plan (NAP) in 2018 for the period 2018-2021. The NAP was developed by a few ministries, including the Ministries of Foreign Affairs; National Defence; and Interior and Administration, as well as the Government Plenipotentiary for Equal Treatment, through a participatory process that included public consultations with non-governmental organizations.

The delegation of Poland strongly cares about women's rights. The NAP has four major objectives that focus on the need to increase women's participation in peace processes, peacekeeping missions and operations; the need to strengthen women's role in decision-making processes related to ensuring peace; and the need to protect and support women and children in conflict and in post-conflict settings. In 2020, we announced that we will be withdrawing from the Istanbul Convention due to the fact that critics of the



treaty believe that the convention violates parents' rights by requiring schools to teach children about gender ideology that go against Polish family traditions.

The nuclear disarmament process is heavily influenced by regional geography. The situation in Northeast Asia has deteriorated alarmingly in recent months. Poland deeply believes that nuclear disarmament and the less use of WMD process cannot begin without first establishing international safety and security first.

We as Poland propose the idea of cost-free literacy and numeracy education to break the poverty cycle as the right to have an education is a human right.
