Esteemed delegates, honorable chairs, and most distinguished conference staff,

As the ambassador of the delegation of the United States, on behalf of our delegates, we would like to say that we are very pleased to be a part of this well-organized conference. The United States is located in the North American continent, bordering Canada and Mexico and holds the strongest economy in today's world. The United States has been and currently is an undeniably important force in the UN, serving also as a member of the Permanent 5. As the United States, it has always been our top priority to maintain world peace throughout all types of historical events.

As the delegation of the United States, we are of the belief that the security of a region is a substantial factor in establishing post-conflict peace. Initially, as the Deputy High Commissioner for Human Rights suggests, we believe that "addressing these issues openly and frankly will be critical to the ability of individual states, the international community and the United Nations to improve its work in enhancing security." We have been and currently are trying to help mitigate the suffering of these people by sending vast amounts of humanitarian aid, as showcased in our report published in 2021. We have sent over 15 billion dollars of humanitarian assistance to displaced people and



refugees, 6.5 of which are to MENA states. From this, we can infer that the U.S. has been a huge contributor of support to conflict areas, helping maintain post-conflict peace and security.

Putin's government in the current world, is committing unacceptable acts against Ukraine while also referring to their multiple war crimes and crimes against humanity as just a simple “special military operation”. There is nothing special about this military operation, the same thing was done in the Soviet-Afghan War and the Russo-Georgian War. All of them are unjust and unprovoked aggressions on Russia's behalf that threaten global peace and stability. As the United States, we will not hold up with this. We will not remain seated while Ukrainians are fleeing their homes. We will not be refraining from supporting the honorable side who fight for liberte, égalite and fraternite. And we urge you, honorable Member States, to do the same and place yourselves with those who defend their homeland.
