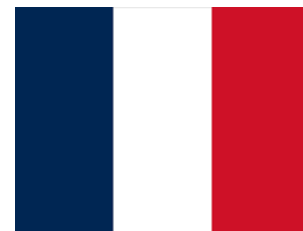

The French Republic has been a member of the United Nations since its founding in 1945. Since then, France has contributed a lot through its active leadership and sponsorship of various resolutions, while taking a leading role on many subjects through its permanent seat in the UN Security Council. It is also represented within the other major UN bodies and within its subsidiary organs. Furthermore, it is the sixth-largest contributor to the United Nations regular budget and to the peacekeeping operations budget.

France has continuously played a role in the human rights field, as it inspired the Universal Declaration of Human Rights which was proclaimed by the United Nations General Assembly in Paris on December 10th, 1948. Today, France continues to fight for human rights worldwide, both through its driving role within the UN Human Rights Council, and through its actions in the Security Council.

Over the past 7 years, the UN has helped to end numerous conflicts, while maintaining post-conflict international peace and security through its diverse bodies and councils, under Goal 16 of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals that calls for the Promotion of Just, Peaceful, and Inclusive Societies.

We must avoid letting any existing conflict progress, by limiting both its direct and indirect consequences, such as food insecurity, energy insecurity, the rising debts of developing countries, the refugee disaster and insufficient health and living conditions, etc.
